David R. Miller, age 62, of rural Creal Springs, IL passed away suddenly at 10:19 a.m. on Friday, January 9, 2015, in the Veterans Administration Medical Center of Marion, IL. He was born on Sunday, July 27, 1952, in Augusta, GA, the son of Preston Franklin and Bertha Raedean (Robinson) Miller.

David attended school in Murphysboro, IL and was a graduate of Murphysboro High School Class of 1970.

After graduation he answered the call of this nation by serving in the United States Army in Vietnam from 1971 to 1974. After his period of faithful service he was discharged with the rank of Specialist Fourth Class.

His working career began with Penn Aluminum until he began with Marion Pepsi from 1974 to 1979, after Pepsi worked for Old Ben No. 25 Coal Company of West Frankfort, IL, after the mine at Container Stapling Company of Herrin, IL, later at Crown Line Boat Company of West Frankfort, IL and finally at Sam's Club of Marion, IL for 11 years until September of 2014.

He was united in marriage to Glenna G. Hartwell on Wednesday, December 25, 1974, at Cana Baptist Church, located on Route 166 near Creal Springs, IL and together they have shared over forty years of marriage.

David was a member of Lone Oak Baptist Church of Energy, IL and also a lifetime member of Heyde-Pillow V.F.W. Post No. 1301 of Marion, IL.

In his spare time he enjoyed spending time outdoors, fishing, hunting, golfing and square dancing.

His family was a very important part of his life. He always looked forward to spending time together and treasured the many memories that were created.

Comments of memory were presented by David's son, Nathan and his son-in-law, Mark Lipe. A special poem called "Daddy" was written and presented by David's daughter, Crystal.

The service began with a special tribute and walk thru by the Illinois Patriot Guard. They also presented to David's wife, Glenna a folded flag and plaque.

The prelude and postlude musical selections were recorded piano selections.
